There are 4 types of goods:

^{&#}x27;Excludable yes' means that it is easy to stop a person from consuming the good.

^{&#}x27;Excludable no' means that it is impossible to stop a person from consuming the good. Problem: Free riding (Why pay?)

^{&#}x27;Rival yes' means that if a person consumes a good it is impossible for another person to consume the same unit.

^{&#}x27;Rival no' means that the same unit of the good can be consumed simultaneously by two or more persons.
